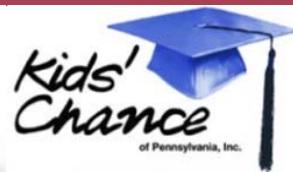


The Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania REPORT CARD

Dear Kids' Chance Supporters and Friends:

In the midst of such economic uncertainty, one would anticipate a decrease in philanthropic support. I am proud to say that this has not been the case for Kids' Chance of PA. Through the goodwill and generosity of our scholar sponsors, corporate and community partners and individual donors, we were able to award \$121,000 in scholarship funds – our highest amount yet – to 48 deserving young people for the academic year of 2010-2011.

Our annual fund-raising events continue to enjoy tremendous support and much success. These events not only help to raise additional scholarship funds, but bring light to our mission and help the organization with its outreach to the community at large. This year we hosted our 5th Annual Golf Outing and Recognition Event in Hershey. This event raised over \$11,000 through the participation of golfers and sponsors. We also hosted the 3rd Annual 5K Walk/Run in Harrisburg and the 2nd Annual 5K Walk/Run in Philadelphia. We even added a 10K to both races resulting in more than 400 runners raising over \$22,000 for Kids' Chance!

What is the secret to Kids' Chance's success? The answer is simple; it is the dedication of our supporters who whole-heartedly believe in our mission. Kids' Chance of PA was founded as a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization in 1997. Since its inception, Kids' Chance of PA has awarded scholarships to over 375 deserving student applicants throughout Pennsylvania.
