Dear Friends of Kids' Chance,

It is my pleasure to share with you some of the highlights of this past year as well as our vision for the future of Kids' Chance of Pennsylvania. For the academic year of 2011-2012, we awarded scholarships to 46 students in an amount totaling \$107,500. Our 6th Annual Golf Outing & Recognition event was held in May at the Hershey Country Club and we welcomed an increased number of golfing participants and dinner attendees. In October 2011, our 5/10K Fun Walk/Run Events were held again in Harrisburg and Philadelphia and we add another event in Pittsburgh to raise our number of participants overall to be 400. We are focusing our energies on several major priorities over the next several years including:

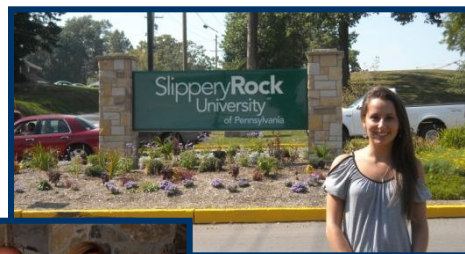
- Updated branding to be more aligned with National Kids' Chance logo and affiliation
- Celebrating the \$1 million dollar mark in scholarship allocations – Wow! We have moved in a relatively short time from an annual allocation of about \$35,000 to more than \$120,000 in scholarship support awarded annually.
- Reaching out to students, not only to new and deserving scholarship recipients, but to continue to engage our scholarship awardees in some fashion as we track their progress during and after the scholarship experience.
- Growing Kids' Chance Board and Committee members to represent the entire state with board representation dispersed geographically and by industry.
- Hosting the National Kids' Chance of America Conference in Pennsylvania in 2014 will be a wonderful opportunity to gain visibility for Kids' Chance of Pa while sharing best practices with our sister Kids' Chance organizations.

I hope to be able to meet and greet as many of our scholars, partners, donors, scholarship recipients and event participants during my term as President of Kids' Chance. I believe your perspectives, input, suggestions and foresight will enable Kids' Chance to better meet the needs of students as they pursue their educational endeavors.

Obviously, Kids' Chance of PA needs the involvement and support of our extended family in order to reach out goals and to address the needs of those we serve...young people advancing academically with the help of Kids' Chance!

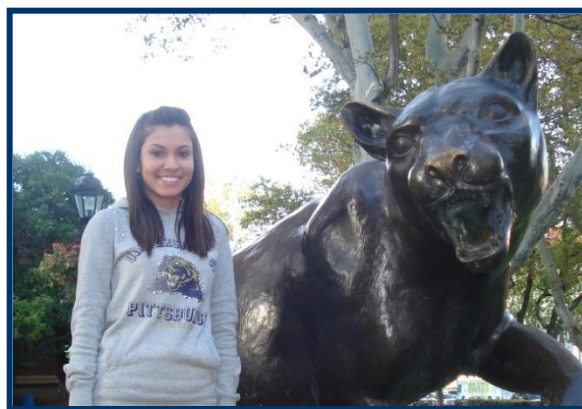

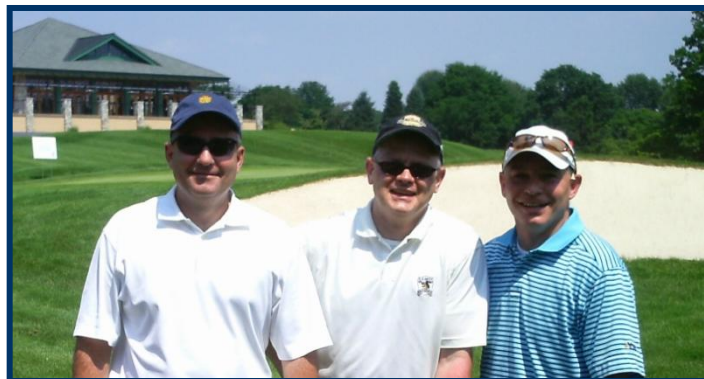

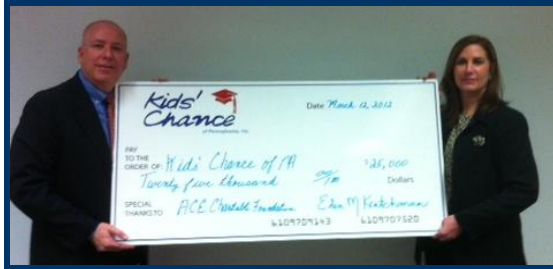
